Quality Assurance Questionnaire Addendum

Mr. Albrecht:

As we get closer to the award of the Woodbury County Law Enforcement project, I would like to take this opportunity to update and clarify two responses to the above-referenced questionnaire provided by Hausmann Construction, Inc. ("Hausmann") on May 28, 2021.

First, question #17 of the questionnaire asks about suits pending or outstanding against Hausmann that are in the course of our business. On June 8th, 2021, after submission of the questionnaire, Bigzbys, Inc. filed suit in the District Court of Hall County, Nebraska against Hausmann for payment on a recent project. Hausmann disputes payment is owed due to workmanship issues by Bigzbys. Hausmann anticipates this matter will be resolved in a timely manner and will not affect our ability to complete the Woodbury County Law Enforcement project. Nonetheless, the timing of our submission and the filing of this claim requires this additional disclosure.

Also, question #26 of the questionnaire asks whether contractor will only utilize on-site employees who have completed the Occupational Safety and Health Act 10-hour construction industry training program. Hausmann initially answered "yes," but qualified this response by adding "supervisory personnel only." This qualification could be confusing. In the interest of clarity, I would like to amend our response to remove the qualifying language. All on-site employees utilized on this project will have the OSHA 10-Hour construction industry training program certification.
