EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Woodbury County Emergency Services is recommending the bid award and requesting Woodbury County Board of Supervisors approval to purchase a new 4x4 Medium Duty Rescue Truck.

BACKGROUND: Woodbury County Emergency Services had begun the process of purchasing a new 4x4 Medium Duty Rescue Truck. The advertisement for bids was published in the Sioux City Journal on April 16, 2016. The bids were opened at the May 3, 2016 Woodbury County Board of Supervisors Board Meeting.

The results of bids received:

Jensen #2 (Dodge)	\$44,398.00
