OF WOODBURY COUNTY, IOWA:  
RESOLUTION #13,646**

WHEREAS, Woodbury County has a renewed interest in seeing our county grow for the benefit of families, residents, and future generations. In short, we want to grow the right way as stewards of the land entrusted to us from our forebearers and leave our county an even better place to work, live and raise a family for future generations; and

WHEREAS, During the past five years, the county has been confronted by several energy ideas that often seem shortsighted, trading short-term gain for the long-term pain that could degrade the land, safety, private property rights, quality of life, and the true economic growth; and

THEREFORE, Woodbury County supports:

- Economical and dependable forms of energy that have helped historically build America such as coal and natural gas and urges technologies that improve environmental stewardship and are not dependent on weather which has proven to cause shortages when needed most.
- Recognizing the long-term sustainability of coal-fired electricity and the jobs necessary to support it at Port Neal.
- Mindfulness for landowners and families who reside on the land over and above the interests of out-of-state companies and absentee landowners whose projects may negatively affect the quality of life and future economic prosperity.
- An absolute right for private property land rights with a rejection of the use of eminent domain to force landowners to place pipelines, turbines, solar panels, or any other energy commodity of their land against their will and consent.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

A resolution establishing a new speed limit from the US 75 overpass on Correctionville Road to Buchanan Avenue is proposed.

**BACKGROUND:**

The county engineer has completed a speed study for Correctionville Road east of Sioux City. A 45 mph speed limit is recommended for portions of the road east of the US 75 overpass to Buchanan Avenue. The resolution is presented for the board's approval.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

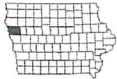

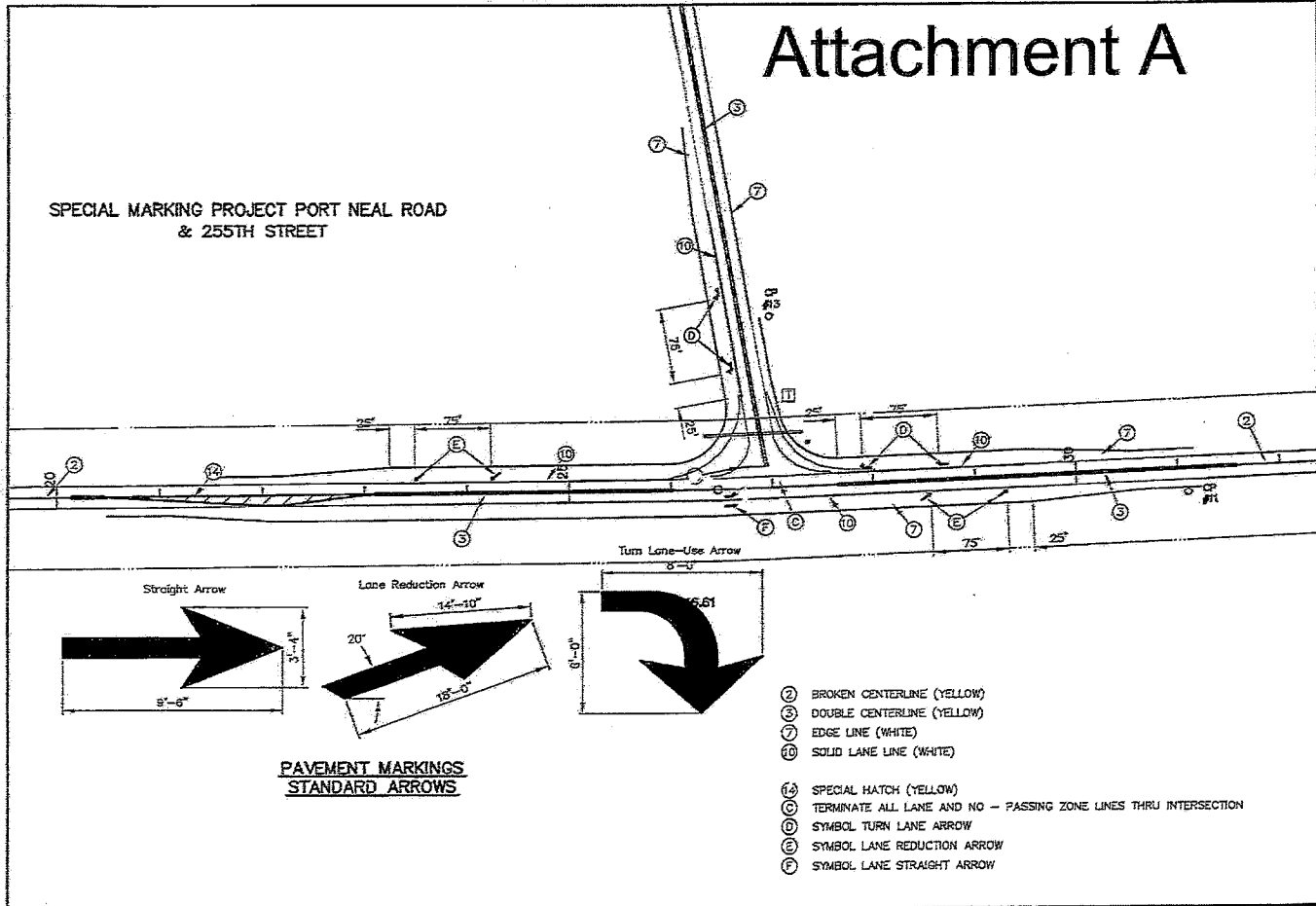

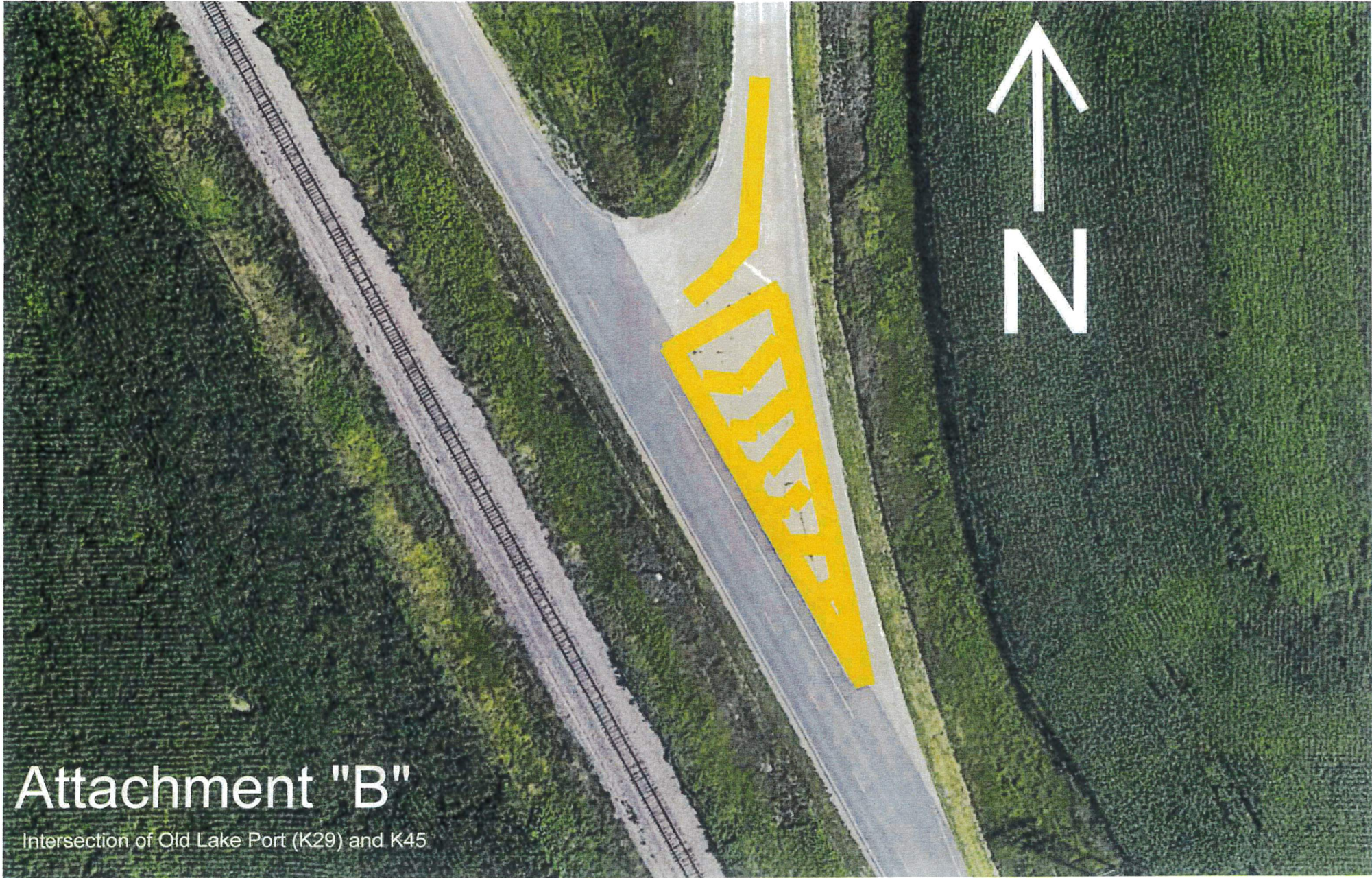
