

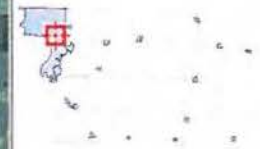

The Center averaged 14.6 residents per day during the 6:00 a.m. head count and 14.7 during the 6:00 p.m. check for a weekly average of 14.65 residents per day during the above week.

Of the fourteen residents detained on June 2, 2014, six or twenty nine percent were identified as gang members. Of the six two or thirty three percent were identified has highly active.

We are currently detaining five juveniles from the BIA and one juvenile from Dakota County.
