

Petition to Reject Iowa DOT Project Closing I-29 Overpasses Between Salix and Sloan, Iowa

Petition Summary and Background:

The time and location of the public meeting to discuss the potential Iowa DOT project to close two I-29 overpasses located at Carrol Avenue and 310th Street between the Salix and Sloan, Iowa interchanges is being held in Sioux City, not one of the affected communities, and at a time not conducive for residents in the affected areas to be able to attend. This petition was created so that the voices of residents in Salix, Sloan and the surrounding areas affected by this potential project can be heard.
