Installation Fee: \$35.00
Daily usage fee: \$16.00 per day
MEMS usage fee: \$7.00 per day

Minimum due at hook-up w/o **MEMS:**
\$163.00
\$112.00 every 7 days.

Minimum due at hook-up with **MEMS:**
\$219.00
\$161.00 every 7 days.

* Must pay each week in advance.

*Must pay 1st day and last day hooked up.

*Payments are made in E.M. Office weekly between the hours of 7am to 3pm.

*CASH Payments must be **EXACT, no change.**

*Money Orders / Cashiers checks are acceptable.

NO PERSONAL CHECKS !!!

Payments can also be made using a *CREDIT / DEBIT CARD*. Credit Card **MUST** be **MASTERCARD** or **VISA**.



IF YOU ARE REQUIRED TO BE ON AN ALCOHOL TESTING UNIT:

(all alcohol related charges require this unit)

- You report to the EM Office for the hookup.
- Officers will bring MEMS unit to your residence for installation after you leave the EM office.
- You unplug ALL equipment and return to EM office on date you are scheduled to be released, **AFTER** you receive call from EM staff authorizing you to do so.

On your hook up day:

- Your work / school schedule.
- Any changes in persons living at residence since interview.
 - Your first payment
- Clean U.A. (mandatory, done in EM office, day of your hook up)
- Ride to and from our office if you do not have valid drivers license.

ELECTRONIC MONITORING RULES AND REGULATIONS



The Woodbury County Sheriff's Office offers an in-house detention program using a GPS electronic monitoring system. The program provides an alternative to incarceration for certain approved non-violent offenders who may require less than institutional custody.

HOW TO APPLY:

- * You and your Attorney must complete an application form and submit it to the EM Office for review.
- * After the application information has been given to the EM Office, **YOU** must contact the EM Office (712-279-6594) for an Interview.
 - * During the interview, rules and regulations will be discussed with you and a tentative hook-up date is set.
 - * After the interview the application will either be approved or denied and then forwarded to the sentencing Judge to review for sentencing.



RULES:

- Approval by Judge and EM Staff.
 - No escape convictions.
 - Agree to alcohol/drug screening
 - Agree to random home visits
- No conviction for forcible felony or crimes involving serious injury.
- Must not have any active warrants from any other jurisdiction.
 - Agree to special conditions if alcohol violations require additional alcohol testing equipment.
- **No applicants accepted for a period less than seven (7) days.**
 - + Case by case basis
