

ORDINANCE NO. 15

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RESTRICTED PARKING ADJACENT TO CITY OF MOVILLE.

Be It Enacted by the Woodbury County Board of Supervisors, Woodbury County, Iowa:

**SECTION 1. SECTION ADDED.**

A. Merville Frontage Road, also known as "Old Highway 20" which lies outside the corporate limits of the City of Merville shall have restricted or limited parking as further described herein:

1. There shall be no parking at any time on the traveled portion of Merville Frontage Road, the traveled portion being defined as the surface of the road from curb to curb but excluding the shoulder of said road.

2. Beginning at the intersection of Merville Frontage Road and Fair Street and continuing west 185 feet to the alley there shall be no parking on the south side of Merville Frontage Road including the shoulder.

3. Beginning 185 feet west of the intersection of Merville Frontage Road and Fair Street and continuing west 300 feet to the intersection of Merville Frontage Road and East Drive parking shall be restricted to 12 continuous hours utilizing the shoulder of the south side of Merville Frontage Road

4. Beginning with the intersection of East Drive and Merville Frontage Road and continuing west on Frontage Road to South Fourth Street parking shall be restricted to 6 continuous hours.

5. Beginning with South Fourth Street and continuing west on Frontage Road to State Highway 140 there shall be no parking on traveled portion or shoulder at any time.

B. Violation of this ordinance is a county infraction punishable by a fine of \$25.00

**SECTION 2. REPEALER.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law and when appropriate signage is erected and placed upon Highway 20 to give notice of the ordinance.

**SECTION 5. COSTS AND ENFORCEMENT.** The cost of signage shall be paid by the City of Merville. In addition to the County Sheriff, this ordinance may be enforced by any peace officer serving on the Merville Police Department.
