Approve Minutes of the January 10th, 2018 Regular Meeting

Sloan made a motion to approve the minutes, Lawton seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Update on County Fire 800 Paging system

Glenn Sedivy explained that the paging system was completely up and operational, it was discovered that the in-building coverage issues is worse than expected in Danbury and Smithland area. The Sheriff's department also experiences portable coverage issues in this area, especially in building. The County owns a tower between Danbury and Oto that the County Fire paging and talk back system has operated on for years and would make a good site to add the 800 MHz trunked system to. Glenn checked with Motorola any they gave him a preliminary budget number of \$650,000.00 to add equipment to this site.

After further discussion Pierson made a motion to authorize Glenn to work with Motorola on a final price and a financial plan and bring it to the next meeting, the County Supervisors seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Update on County Fire 800 Radio system

Glenn explained that most of the County Fire radios have been installed and Electronic Engineering is still working on the headset interfaces, but project is going very well.

Update on Sioux City Fire Station alerting system

The Sioux City Fire Department has ordered the system from US Digital Designs and is expected to be completed before July.
