Danbury Tower

Work at Danbury tower has been completed with new monitor equipment on the generators. Propane line that has been laying on top of the ground has been buried by Johnson Propane.

Discussed the propane leak discovered at the WIT tower and how important the WIT tower is to the infrastructure of our network. Without the WIT tower we have no radio system being the primary site.

Microwave radio system upgrade, WIT, and West sites

Work is still pending on microwave radio replacements.

Approval of software upgrade for radio service monitor for price of \$955. Bronson made motion to approve and Pierson second the motion, all were in favor.
