Star Control will provide 3 air flow stations for supply and return fans of AHU-1 (2 for supply fans and 1 for return fans). There will be air flow monitoring to each fan in the fan arrays (12 supply fans and 4 return fans). Star Control will add an enclosure with power transformers to power the new air flow stations. With this cost will include user graphics added to the BAS to monitor these new air flow references. We will program this to the sequence provided by Corey Metzger. This work will be billed as time and material with a cost not to exceed.
