

ORDINANCE REGULATING
GOING-OUT-OF-BUSINESS SALES

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Woodbury County Board of Supervisors:

SECTION ONE: DEFINITIONS:

A) The term "merchandise" includes any objects, wares, goods, commodities, intangibles, securities, bonds, debentures, stocks, real estate, or services;

B) The term "person" includes any natural person or his legal representative, partnership, corporation (domestic and foreign), company, trust, business entity or association, and any agent, employee, salesperson, partner, officer, director, member, stockholder, associate, trustee, or cestui que trust thereof;

C) The term "sale" includes any sale, offer for sale, or attempt to sell any merchandise at reduced rates due to the cessation of business operations.

SECTION TWO: PROHIBITED CONDUCT:

It is a prohibited practice in Woodbury County to conduct a going-out-of-business sale in which additional merchandise of the liquidating business is added for the purposes of the sale.

SECTION THREE: WHEN EFFECTIVE:

This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
