

**EPT**EMBER 13, 2013-SPECIAL MEETING OF THE WOODBURY COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS The Board of Supervisors met on Friday, September 13, 2013, at 9:00 a.m. Board members present were Boykin, Clausen, Smith, and Monson; Tripp was absent. Staff members present were Patrick F. Gill, Auditor/Clerk to the Board and Steve Hofmeyer, Deputy Commissioner of Elections.

The meeting was called to order to canvass the Regular School Board Election held in Woodbury County on September 10, 2013.
