Request to Bid:

RML Architects requests the Woodbury County Board of Supervisor's permission to pursue bids for additional cameras in the Law Enforcement Center at 407 7th Street, in Sioux City, Iowa.

Purpose of work: Liability Prevention, Officer and Public Safety

Scope of Work as follows:

Replace low resolution cameras not already replaced. Add additional cameras in areas not currently under surveillance or where dangerous blind spots occur. Record and monitor additional camera information.

A. (12) Twelve additional cameras in the Main Lobby and Court Room Hallways

- 2 additional areas under surveillance
- Multiple blind spots eliminated

B. (17) Seventeen additional cameras in Jail Hallways

- 6 additional areas under surveillance
- Multiple blind spots eliminated

C. (24) Twenty four additional cameras in the Temporary Holding Cells

- 20 additional areas under surveillance
- Resolution of 4 existing cameras improved

D. (16) Sixteen cameras for the Dayroom Camera System

- Replacement of 12 existing low resolution cameras
- Cameras added to eliminate blind spots

E. (7) Seven additional cameras in Multi-Purpose Rooms, etc.

- 7 additional areas under surveillance

Existing cameras:

Main Floor: 10 Areas with camera surveillance, 12 cameras

Jail Level: 21 Areas with camera surveillance, 42 existing cameras
