AFTER SCHOOL & SUMMER PROGRAMS

- The Sanford Center serves 35-49 children each day in our After School Program.
- Supper is provided each evening to the After School children and we serve on average 560 meals a month.
- Morningside College, Briar Cliff University, Sioux City Schools and Heelan High send their students to work with our After School children as mentors and tutors.
- Summer Program serves 25 elementary children Monday-Friday 8 am- 4 pm for seven weeks of educational classes, field trips, guest speakers, breakfast/lunch/snacks and swimming.

ALTERNATIVE SUSPENSION PROGRAM

- The Sanford Center Alternative Suspension Program averages 120 to 150 students from Sioux City Schools each academic year.
- One-third of these suspensions are elementary children.
- The Sanford Center has two certified teachers and one teacher aide in the Alternative Suspension Program.
- Referrals are made by administrators and assignments provided to our teachers by teachers of the Sioux City Schools.



GANG OUTREACH PROGRAM

- The Sanford Center has eight Outreach Specialists in seven schools in the Sioux City Community School District K-12. Outreach Specialists are assigned to a school during the school year but also work with their caseload students during the summer months.
- Our Outreach Specialists have more than 280 caseload and non-caseload students they work with every month. All services are fully documented. Documentation is submitted and reviewed monthly by the Outreach Supervisor.
- The Sanford Center Outreach Program keeps more than 280 youngsters in school, out of the law enforcement system and in their homes annually.



ASIAN FESTIVAL

- The Sanford Center sponsors the Asian Festival every year at Riverside Park with over 400 people in attendance.
- The Sanford Center helped the Asian Community establish the Buddhist Temple in South Sioux City, Nebraska.
