#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

To consider a request of allocating \$1,000 (Gaming Revenue) for a budget to develop and implement an Employee Contribution Campaign for the United Way of Siouxland, with a goal of raising \$29,922.20

#### BACKGROUND:

County employees are raising funds for the United Way Community Impact Fund, which supports education, income, and health initiatives for families in Siouxland. Last year, the Board approve \$1,000 and 2 PTO days for the campaign. Last year county employees raised \$27,202 in total. We hope to increase the number of employees who donate and increase donations by 10%.


