Property owners Ronald and Linda M. Clausen have filed a re-zoning petition for a single 26.3 acre parcel. The re-zoning petition requests a change from the current AP (Agricultural Preservation) zoning district designation to AE (Agricultural Estates) for residential development purposes.

The Applicant has also filed a Minor Subdivision application proposing a three (3) lot subdivision to be named Clausen Acres Addition. As the current AP zoning limits the residential density allowed the requested rezoning provides for the residential density potential of the subdivision.

Should the re-zoning petition and subdivision applications be approved the applicants have a purchase agreement in place for one of the three lots; the applicants will continue to reside on one of the lots; with the third lot intended to remain in agricultural production. The location is within 2,800 feet of Sioux City at the northeast corner of the intersection of paved Buchanan Ave. and graveled 155th St. The parcel is currently addressed 1543 155th St. and located within a portion of the SENW of Section 32 in Concord Township.

Attachments for your review are recapped within the following companion agenda item.

Your Board is asked to forward the re-zoning petition applicator to the Zoning Commission for public hearing and recommendation.

2. Referral to Zoning Commission for Public Hearing and Recommendation on the Final Platting for: Clausen Acres Addition – a minor subdivision; GIS Parcel #894632100011.

This agenda item is a companion filing with the previous agenda item. Property owners Ronald and Linda M. Clausen have filed a Minor Subdivision Application for a three (3) lot subdivision of the existing 24.29 acre parent parcel.

Average Corn Suitability Rating (CSR) for the existing parcel is 39.43 and within Woodbury County policy limits permitting subdivision. Approximately 19 of the 26 acres is in row crop agricultural production with the remaining acres in residential development, pasture or in timber.

A staff recommendation will include: 1.) A Paving Agreement be recorded for the 155th St. graveled right-of way abutting the subdivision's

southern boundary; and 2.) The approval of the subdivision by the city of Sioux City pursuant to the city's extra-territorial right of review.



The Department of Rural Economic Development for Woodbury County, lowa fully supports the City of Onawa, lowa with their application for a 2015 Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) Discretionary Grant. As the Department of Rural Economic Development is devoted to providing economic opportunities for rural communities, we are fully committed to this endeavor. The lead applicant, Onawa, lowa serves a small rural agricultural community with a population of 2,937 (US Census, 2013 estimate). It is a rural community nestled between the Loess Hills and the Missouri River along the I-29 corridor. Onawa serves as the county seat of Monona County, and is the largest town on the lowa side of the Missouri River between Sioux City, IA and Council Bluffs, IA.

The proposed project, known locally as the "K45 Rural Corridor Project", is a regionally important roadway improvements project by which a multi-modal connection to community employment centers, education, and services for non-drivers and drivers will be constructed. Ronald N. and Linda M. Clausen have filed an application and final platting to subdivide 26.3 acres into three (3) lots. The applicants currently reside on the parent parcel within an existing single family dwelling. The applicants wishes to sell one of the lots for residential development; establish a second lot for the applicant's existing dwelling and outbuildings; with the third lot to consist of the reminder of the parent parcel currently in, and intending to remain, in agricultural production.

The parent parcel lies in rural Woodbury County approximately 2,800 feet from the Sioux City corporate limits at the northeast corner of 155th St and Buchanan Avenue. The location is within a portion of the SE ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 32 in Concord Township. The parent parcel is zoned AP (Agricultural Preservation); not within a special flood hazard area; does not lie within any drainage district and is serviced by a drive addressed 1543 155th St. along with multiple field entrances. The applicants have also filed an application for re-zoning the same acres from the current AP zoning designation to AE (Agricultural Estates) designation to allow for the intended additional residential development.
