BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WOODBURY COUNTY, IOWA:
SECTION 1 . The Woodbury County Sheriff's Office is authorized to waive the residency requirement for reserve police officers on a case by case basis, as defined in Iowa Admin, Code § 501-10.100(1).
SECTION 2 . All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
SECTION 3 . Should any section, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, that decision shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Bids were received for construction of two new Reinforced Concrete Box culverts to replace existing bridges L77 and L78 on 200th Street south of Cushing. An award recommendation is being presented.											
BACKGROUND:											
The county programmed bridge L77 and L78 for replacement in fiscal year 2018. The existing bridges are structurally deficient and functionally obsolete and has a restricted load posting.
