Bids were received on July 2, 2019 for PCC Patching damaged pavement on Old 141 near the Wolf Creek Bridge. The county engineer is recommending award.				
BACK	KGROUND:			
Old Highway 141 was damaged by flash flooding the week of March 12, 2019. The pavement and shoulder were washed out when the road overtopped with flood water. The road embankment and shoulders have been rebuilt by county staff, temporary surfacing has been placed and the road reopened to traffic. Bids have been received from Iowa DOT and an award recommendation is being made.				
FINAN	NCIAL IMPACT:			
This repair is initially paid for with farm to market funds. We are applying for FHWA Emergency Relief funds for repairing the road, but in my judgment we can't wait for award of the funds to make for the repair. We are still eligible for funds, but we do take a risk by doing the work ahead of award.
