WHEREAS, local government funding reimbursements may only be used for necessary expenditures incurred due to the COVID-19 pandemic, were not accounted for in the current fiscal year county budget, were incurred during the time period of March 1, 2020 through December 30, 2020 and have not been reimbursed from other sources.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Woodbury County requests reimbursement of \$1,307,191.28 in eligible expenditures in response to the COVID-19 public health emergency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Woodbury County affirms that the above requests for reimbursement follow all formal published Federal and State of Iowa guidance on how the funds should be spent, and understand if the reimbursements are misrepresented, the local government will be liable for any applicable penalty and interest.

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding entered into by and between Woodbury County, Iowa (Employer) and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Iowa Public Employee Council 61, AFL-CIO, Juvenile Detention (Union), effective August 4, 2020, and continuing until such time as the parties shall agree otherwise:

The Employer desires to create a new position titled a "Case Manager." The Employer and the Union agree that the "Case Manager" will be a salaried provision and not subject to any of the overtime or similar provisions of the existing Contract. Similarly, the provisions of Article V-Hours of Work and Overtime, Section 1, Section 2, and Section 5-8 will not be applicable to the Case Manager. The Case Manager will meet with families after hours and will need to have flexible and fluctuating hours to complete tasks as assigned. The Case Manager will work with her supervisor and or the director to keep them apprised of the work hours necessary to complete her duties as assigned.

Article VI Wages, Job Classifications and Fringe Benefits, Section 1-3, Section 5, Section 6, and Sections 9-12 will similarly not be applicable to the Case Manager. The Case Manager will be paid on the following pay scale:

6.5% increase after 6 years of service	\$71,429.52

The Case Manager will also be entitled to any additional cost of living increases negotiated as part of the Union Contract.

With the exception of the aforementioned, the Case Manager will have all the benefits and obligations associated with the existing Union Contract including continuing to accrue seniority.

By entering into this Memorandum of Understanding the Employer does not concede that the position is part of the Bargaining Unit or that it will continue to be such in the future. The Employer and the Union reserve the right to reevaluate this Agreement in the future and the Case Manager position develops and duties are established.







EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Plans were completed for replacement of bridge B-203 with a 150' X 30' continuous concrete slab bridge. The project was let to bid by Iowa DOT on August 19, 2020. Signed contracts returned.

BACKGROUND:

The county has programmed the replacement of bridge B-203 on 200th Street west of the Moville Blacktop for FY 2021. The existing bridge was closed due to substructure failure in October 2019 and plans for replacement were accelerated to replace the closed structure with a 1500' X 30' continuous concrete slab bridge.

The county's Federal aid-SWAP fund, managed by Iowa DOT, is providing 100% of project cost.



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Woodbury County has the potential to collect \$1,307,191.28 in Local Government Relief Funding from the State of Iowa. The first reimbursement deadline is Sept 15th and covers the period of 03-01-20 thru 07-31-20. Emergency Management met with the deputy auditor, public health, and public safety administrators to discuss the funding. It was agreed that the most effective option to request for reimbursement would be using the data and supporting documentation from payroll. Allowed expenditures include payroll costs for public health and public safety employees for services dedicated to mitigating or responding to the COVID-19 public health emergency. The state allows us to presume that 25% payroll costs for public health employees are payments for services substantially dedicated to mitigating or responding to the COVID-19 public health emergency. Other COVID related expenditures may be eligible for reimbursement though FEMA and will be managed by Emergency Management.

The departments have been identified as public health and public safety are: Sheriff's Office, Emergency Services, District Health, Juvenile Detention, and Emergency Management. Only regular pay that is not covered by other grants is included in the request.

BACKGROUND:

Governor Kim Reynolds has allocated \$125 million for reimbursements to local governments for direct expenses incurred in response to the COVID-19 emergency.

\$100 million for reimbursement will be divided between eligible cities and counties by 2019 estimated population. \$25 million will be used to cover the local government portion of the FEMA match through the lowa Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.

Consistent with the U.S. Treasury Department Guidance, funds may only be used to cover costs that:

A. Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);

B. Were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020, for the government entity;

C. Were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020; and

D. Have not been reimbursed or where reimbursement has not been requested from another source of funds including, but not limited to, other federal programs.

A reimbursement for payroll expenses in the amount of \$1,307,191.28.

InCode has an update available for the tax deferment, but it is up to us to decide if we want to take advantage of the deferment. The upgrade is available on the 16th.

Our external auditor advises against opting in to the deferment since there are still some questions on how it gets repaid with the potential of withholding twice as much in 2021 to account for the deferred taxes.

BACKGROUND:

The Department of Treasury and Internal Revenue Service issued guidance (PDF) implementing the Presidential Memorandum issued on August 8, 2020, allowing employers to defer withholding and payment of the employee's portion of the Social Security tax if the employee's wages are below a certain amount.

Notice 2020-65, posted on IRS.gov, makes relief available for employers and generally applies to wages paid starting September 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020.

The employee Social Security tax deferral may apply to payments of taxable wages to an employee that are less than \$4,000 during a bi-weekly pay period, with each pay period considered separately.
