RESOLUTION AMENDING THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT LEVY AND CERTIFICATE TO THE AUDITOR OF WOODBURY COUNTY

RESOLUTION NO. 12,017

WHEREAS, The Woodbury County Board of Supervisors is the governing body of the Smithland District of Woodbury County, and

WHEREAS, said Board, as Trustees and in response to a petition from affected landowners, has determined it is necessary to levy a special tax and/or assessment for the purpose of improving the integrity and protection of the levee on the left bank of the Little Sioux River and that said tax is assessed against all tracts of land protected by said levee and only that benefitted part of said District, and

WHEREAS, said Board, in resolution number 11495, did on December 10, 2013 approve said levy, and

WHEREAS, an error was found when applying the tax levy to properties affected by said resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Woodbury County Board of Supervisors as the governing body of the Smithland District amends the distribution of the special tax and/or assessment in the sum of \$98,000.00 levied against the benefitted tracts of land in the ratio herein established, adopted and confirmed as follows:




BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said special tax and/or assessment in the sum of \$98,000.00 shall be spread over three years at no interest to the benefitted parcels with the project cost to be loaned to the district from the Local Option Sales and Service Tax Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said levy and/or assessment be and the same is hereby certified to the Woodbury County Auditor who is hereby directed to effect said levy and /or assessment against all of the said benefitted lands, etc. in the ratio and percentage and upon the same classification as heretofore amended, adopted, established and confirmed and enter the same upon the tax list of Woodbury County for collection beginning with the first half of the real estate taxes payable September, 2014.


