A total of Sixty-eight (68) people voted.

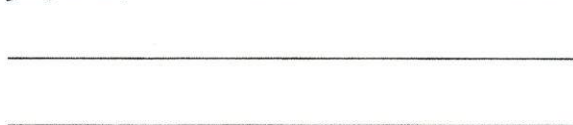
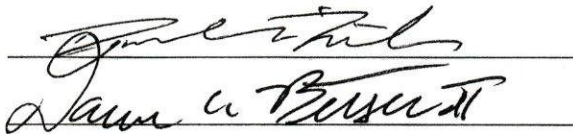
