

# **Options to Vote in the November 3, 2020 General Election**

## **Early Voting – ALL Woodbury County Voters**

Complete an Absentee Ballot Request Form, send it to the Auditor's Office, and cast your ballot in the comfort and safety of your home. Ballots will be mailed starting Monday, October 5.

## **Early In-Person Voting – All Woodbury County Voters**

This service is available at the Courthouse at 620 Douglas Street during the same hours listed above. Call 712-279-6465 when you arrive at the northside entrance to the Courthouse on Seventh Street. Two parking spots will be reserved and marked for this purpose.

## **Satellite Voting – ALL Woodbury County Voters**

Briar Cliff University, Morningside College, and Western Iowa Tech Community College have the opportunity to have a satellite voting site for one day each if students are on campus.

## **Polling Places on Election Day, November 3, 2020 – ALL Woodbury County Voters**

Every voter must vote at their assigned polling place on Election Day.

All Woodbury County polling places located outside of Sioux City will be open depending on the availability of Precinct Election Officials.

A minimum of 13 buildings will be open to host polling places for the 28 precincts located in Sioux City depending on the availability of Precinct Election Officials.
